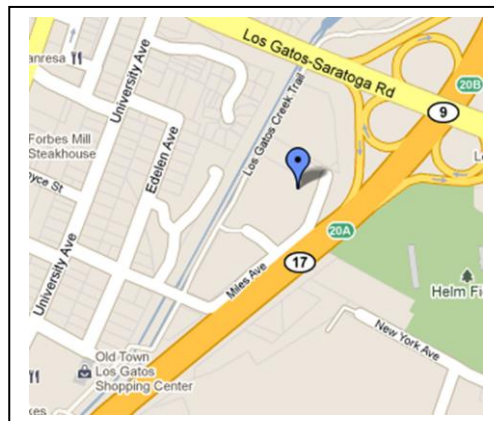

In 2009, 20% of U.S. high school students had ever taken a prescription drug, such as Oxycontin, Percocet, Vicodin, Adderall, Ritalin, or Xanax, without a doctor's prescription. Teens also misuse over-the-counter cough and cold medications, containing the cough suppressant dextromethorphan (DXM), to get high. Prescription and over-the-counter medications are widely available, free or inexpensive, and falsely believed to be safer than illicit drugs. Misuse of prescription and over-the-counter medications can cause serious health effects, addiction, and death.
